1. Meeting opened to the Pledge of Allegiance @ 7:10 PM in the Hamden Inn.
2. Last months minutes read by Don Bender motion to accept by Steve Reed, second by Robbie Andersen.
3. Financial Report read by Lauren Fletcher motion to accept by Mike Drew, second by Bill Sprague. Bills were submitted to be paid. Motion made to pay bills by Joe Caso, second by Mike Drew.
4. Trails: Earl made a motion for \$150.00 to brush hog the trail from Delaware Sport Center up to County Route 26, second by Steve Reed. The trail just above Hiltons on Cascarelli's property needs a sleuce pipe installed and a maple tree taken down. Roger Dibble has agreed to put in the sleuce and Earl will ask him about taking down the tree. A new bridge needed behind Tony Caleo. The bridge at Phil Seidens needs three new pieces of plywood to fix the decking. Don Bender has plywood he will donate for the bridge. The fence has to be put back up on Kim Scanlons berm. Also Robbie Andersen made a motion for \$250.00 for repairing a bridge on Bagley Brook, second by Steve Reed.
5. Signing of all trails needs to be done ASAP. Earl needs four S-29 signs for trail leaving Austin Lincoln Park.
6. An electrical inspection needs to be done on our storage building so we can have pumps put in our fuel tanks. Don Bender is going to ask the electrical inspector that he uses to inspect the building.
7. John Kowatch out of Margaretville needs to be called to deliver 300 gallons of off road diesel.
8. After discussion of who will operate the Pisten Bully it was decided that they will have a class about operating this piece of equipment. Those interested in operating the Pisten Bulley are Bill Wright, Bill Sprague, Don Bender, Earl Sines, and Eric Alexander.
9. Where to keep the Pisten Bulley? There was three locations that came up for discussion Bill Spragues Garage, the Storage Garage, and Gerald's Garage. After a show of hands the Pisten Bulley will be kept at Bill's. They want to keep it where there is snow. It does not snow down in the valley.
10. All of the groomers will be serviced by the dealerships of there manufacturer. Call the dealerships to have your groomer picked up for service.
11. Marilyn will call and see if the Walton Fire Department is interested in doing the food at the Snowmobile Winterfest again this year. Joe Caso will be making diagrams of the snowmobile races to send to the insurance company.
12. Doing something in memory of Gary Tweedie has been tabled until next meeting. A plaque to put in the secretarys office or naming the snowmobile races after him was two more suggestions.
13. The trail on Hiltons property has been closed. There are two gates on the property that belong to HHRR. John Perico said he could get the gates back in our possession so we can use them on another landowners property.

15. Opening a trail to the Rainbow Lodge was discussed. Aaron Shelton and Fran Reed are going to look into what it would take to possibly get a trail to the Rainbow.
